- ♦ The best three individual scores will count towards the team's total.
- ♦ The winning team will be inscribed on Perpetual Trophy held at UYPC with individual trophies awarded to each team member
- ♦ Riders must enter as individuals to be eligible as a team and compete in all 3 events

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
2. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate.
4. PCAV membership cards must be inspected at the secretary's office before riding.
5. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks may be conducted throughout the day. If helmets do not meet regulations, the competitor may be eliminated.
6. **NO CARD, NO RIDE.**
7. Gear Check - required for all riders 20 minutes before each event.
8. Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
9. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
10. Competitors may ride more than one horse competitively, subject to ballot of entries. Preferences will be based on listed order on entry form.
11. Armbands: Must be worn by all competitors.
12. Dogs and alcohol are prohibited without exception.
13. Entry fee includes \$1 Zone Levy
14. No lungeing permitted.
15. Competitor numbers: Bridle or saddlecloth numbers supplied by competitors or body numbers by organising committee.
16. This event will comply with the PCAV EI and Biosecurity Guidelines which are current at the time of the event.
17. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

Rules and Conduct
By-Laws of the Upper Yarra Pony Club
Code of Conduct

- ♦ **Members must comply with the Codes of Conduct as determined by the Pony Club Association of Victoria (PCAV). Codes of conduct apply to Riding Members, Adult Supports, Officials, Administrators and Coaches/Instructors**
- ♦ **These by-laws are the Club's policies and procedures and must be read in conjunction with the Club's Rules of Incorporation (Constitution) and PCAV Rules in the Handbook of By-Laws, both linked from the Club's website**
- ♦ **A parent or nominated guardian must be in attendance with Junior Members at all times. If a parent/guardian must leave during the rally, another guardian must be appointed**
- ♦ **Members are expected to present, unmounted, for line-up and gear check at the specified time. All riders must adhere to gear check rule as specified by PCAV rules. If late, a member must report to the DC and then wait until their instructor tells them to join in**
- ♦ **Anyone outside the class wishing to speak to a member in the class must first obtain the Instructors permission to do so**
- ♦ **Members must not leave the Pony Club venue without permission of the DC and must report to them before leaving for home if leaving prior to the last session of the day**
- ♦ **Attendance will only be given to members (and marked in their cards) if they fully partake (including active riding) in at a minimum of two of the scheduled sessions of each rally or compete at CZ qualifying events when they fall on rally days. However, with prior approval of the DC, attendance will also be given where the rider is only able to participate in two of the sessions on a maximum of TWO occasions each membership year. Unmounted attendance may be granted at the discretion of the DC**
- ♦ **Note: In these rules, the work 'member' includes anyone on a horse or pony at a rally of the UYPC**
- ♦ **At a Pony Club Rally, unless under instruction from appointed Pony Club Instructors, members may not trot, canter or gallop on Pony Club grounds except under Instruction; or jump any obstacle or use any equipment.**
- ♦ **Members may not change horses or allow any member or non-member on their designated mount for the day, except with permission of the DC or their appointee, or the member's Instructor**
